TB Program: We only have 68 patients enrolled under TB treatment, where 53 are adults and 15 are children this year due to many missed opportunities for TB diagnosis, slowing down of healthcare processes, difficulty in travelling (which has led to increased transportation costs) and diagnostic laboratories' strict protocols.

Area: Antipolo City

Health Education and Lift Program (HELP): There were no medical and dental mission this year due to the pandemic but we gave

some medicine and vitamins to those in need.

Area: Marilao Bulacan and Trece Cavite

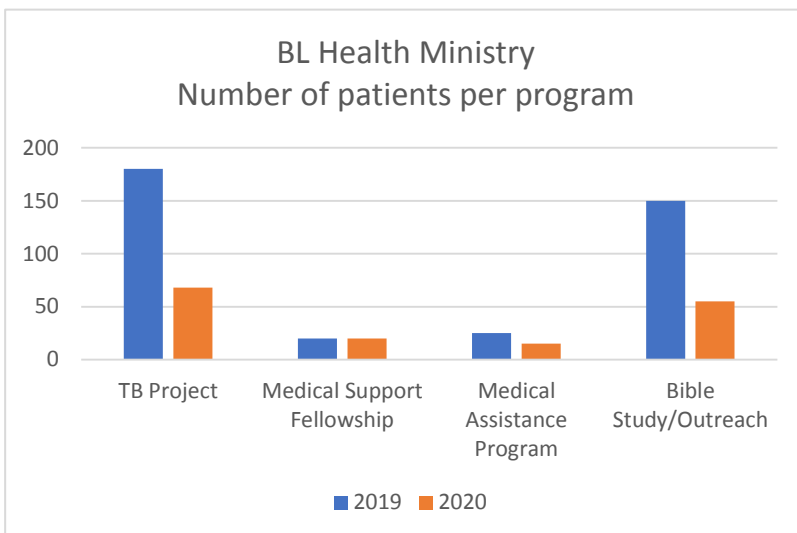
Medical Assistance Program (MAP): Praise GOD for His provision that enabled us to give financial assistance to pay hospital bills, laboratory tests and medicines.

We had to stretch our funds this year due to lack of support in this fund. We just

tried to divide the finances we have among the BL communities who are in need of help.

Cases: Respiratory infections, Hyperthyroidism, Nasopharyngeal cancer, Myasthenia Gravis, Ischemia, Intrauterine fetal death, Rheumatic heart disease, Chest Tube Thoracostomy, Cardiac mass, Heart disease, Diabetes with severe complications.
