Marketplace Christians can be: kingdom professionals, business as missions workers, tentmakers or global professionals.



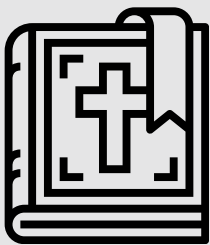
BUSINESS AS MISSIONS IS SUSTAINABLE

We need to teach and enable communities to create wealth, to create products and services.



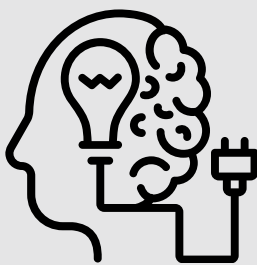
BUSINESS DISCIPLESHIP CAN BE JESUS DISCIPLESHIP
