

Instructions for traveling from [Chitose Airport \(Hokkaido/Sapporo\)](#) to OMF's Hokkaido Center and [Japanese Language Center](#) in Sapporo.

If someone is planning to meet you, you should call and let them know which bus or train you will be on. Hokkaido Center: 011-784-4400 (JLC 011-784-4415)

BY TRAIN

When you arrive at Chitose Airport, go through baggage claim if you checked baggage. If not you may immediately exit.

Go down to the train level when the JR train arrives. This is Shin-Chitose-Airport station. Purchase a ticket for ¥1,040 to Sapporo.

At Sapporo station, exit the JR area into the station, and go to the Toho Subway line (blue signs). Purchase a ticket for ¥240. Board the train headed for Sakaemachi, and get off at Shindohigashi station (10 minutes from Sapporo station).

From there you can easily walk to the OMF Hokkaido Center/Japanese Language Center.

BY BUS

On the same level as the baggage claim, there is a counter and an automatic vending machine selling bus tickets for the Chuo Bus. As different flights come into different areas of the terminal, you may need to walk a bit to get to this area.

The Chuo Bus Line has direct routes to central Sapporo as well as to different areas in Sapporo. You will take the bus going to Asabu, which costs ¥1,000. The bus will pick up passengers at bus stop #14 or #22, but confirm this before boarding. It takes about 50 minutes in summer and 60 – 90 minutes in winter (depending on weather conditions). The Asabu Bus Terminal is the last stop for this bus.
